JUNIOR CITY TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is certified and governed by the general playing rules in Chapter 6 and 7 of the USBC Rule book. Rule 319D, and E do not apply.
2. This tournament is limited to 2011-12 youth members of the Missoula USBC Association. All participants will use their highest 2011-12 average of 12 or more games as of January 1, 2012. If this average is not available, then the highest 2011-12 average of 12 or more games as of the week prior to their first shift bowled will be used. If this is not available, then the bowler will bowl scratch. No participation fees will be accepted.
3. Prize fund will be returned 100% to participants in the form of one \$125 scholarship for the high scratch bowler bowling nine games, and one \$125 scholarship for the high handicap bowler bowling nine games. 2nd and 3rd place finishers in each category will receive a \$75 and \$50 scholarship, respectively. The first nine games bowled will be used in determining scholarship winners. In the case of the same bowler bowling both high scratch and handicap games, the second place high handicap bowlers will be awarded the high handicap scholarship. Scholarships will be submitted to the SMART scholarship management program, administered through USBC National Headquarters. One plaque will be awarded for every six entries in each event, except for All Events. One plaque will be awarded for High Scratch Game and High Scratch Series, for a boy and a girl. If a tie exists for First Place in any event, co-champions will be declared.

Fees are payable with cash, check, or money order payable to Missoula USBC. Entry fees are:

4. There are several performance based awards available during the tournament, each of which can be earned once during the tournament. Turkey Pins are awarded to any bowler bowling three strikes in a row. Bowling Towels are awarded to any bowler bowling 50 pins above their tournament average in a game. \$75 pro shop certificates are awarded to any bowler bowling either 75 pins (50 for bantams) above their average for a game, or 100 pins (65 for bantams) above their three game (two games for bantams) series average, only one \$75 certificate per bowler. Notify a tournament official when you earn one of these awards.
5. This tournament will consist of a four (4) person team event, a three (3) game doubles event, and a three (3) game singles event, all bowled in three divisions. A fourth division for bowlers under the age of 9 as of August 1, 2011 will consist of the same events, except that each event consists of two games. The divisions are:

Teams can bowl and place multiple times provided at least two bowlers are replaced. Teams of the same configuration may bowl more than once, **BUT CAN PLACE ONLY ONCE**. A bowler may bowl and place in doubles more than once, but not with the same partner. Doubles teams of the same configuration may bowl more than once, **BUT CAN PLACE ONLY ONCE**. A bowler may bowl singles multiple times, **BUT CAN PLACE ONLY ONCE**. In the event there is a tie for First Place in any event, co-champions will be declared

6. All entrants must check in 30 minutes prior to their scheduled shift time. Shifts will start when all bowlers are checked in, or promptly at shift time. Late arriving bowlers will receive zeroes until they are ready to bowl. Should a bowler be unable to complete their team event due to an emergency, a substitute will be allowed to complete the team event and the combined score will be counted for that team's total pins. Handicap will be adjusted accordingly.
7. Handicaps using the team method will be 90% of 800 for team, 90% of 400 for doubles, and 90% of 200 for singles. No practice bowling on any lanes assigned for tournament play. No pacers will be allowed.
8. Any bowler behaving in a derogatory or disorderly manner will be removed from the bowling area by tournament officials.
9. Any protest affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be submitted in writing to the tournament manager before prize payments are made. Errors in scoring must be reported to tournament officials within 24 hours.
10. The Missoula USBC Board of Directors shall decide on any question not covered by these tournament rules and shall have the power to hear and act on all protests arising from or under construction of the rules of the Missoula USBC Junior City Championship Tournament. The decision of the Board of Directors is final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC rule 329.
11. The entrants whose names appear hereon or their replacements hereby agree that the Missoula USBC, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies or causes relating thereto or resulting therefore, fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of Missoula USBC.
