MIXED CITY TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is certified and governed by the general playing rules in Chapter 6 and 7 of the USBC Rule book. Rule 319D, and E do not apply.
2. Tournament participation is limited to 2011-12 members of the Missoula USBC Association. All participants will use their highest average from the prior three seasons, 2009-2011. If this is their first year bowling, the highest January 1, 2012 average of 21 or more games will be used. If the January 1 average is not available, then the highest league average for the current season as of the week prior to their first shift bowled will be used (21 or more games). If this is not available, then the bowler will bowl scratch. No participation fees will be accepted.
3. Prize fund will be returned 100% cash (no trophies) in the ratio of 1 in 8 entries for team, doubles, and scratch team, 1 in 20 for Scratch Doubles. Your association will add \$1000 to the prize fund. Fees are payable to Missoula USBC with cash, check, or money order, and must be paid prior to first shift bowled. Entry fees are:

SCRATCH DOUBLES \$18/TEAM

Scratch doubles uses the scratch team series score for doubles. Entry fees are returned 100% in the ratio of 1:20 (one for every twenty entries). This event is normally entered by high average bowlers.

SCRATCH TEAM \$5/BOWLER

Scratch team uses the scratch score for the team. Entry fees are returned 100% in the ratio of 1:8 (one for every eight entries). This event is normally entered by teams consisting of high average bowlers

4. The tournament will consist of four (4) person team events consisting of two male and two female bowlers, and a three (3) game doubles event consisting of a male and female bowler. Both events are bowled in two divisions:

	TEAM	DOUBLES
DIV 1	700+	350+
DIV 2	699-	349-

Teams can bowl and place multiple times provided at least two bowlers are replaced. Teams of the same configuration may bowl more than once, **BUT CAN PLACE ONLY ONCE**. A bowler may bowl and place in doubles more than once, but not with the same partner. Doubles teams of the same configuration may bowl more than once, **BUT CAN PLACE ONLY ONCE**. In the event there is a tie for First Place in any event, co-champions will be declared

5. Shift times are available to bowl both team and doubles events. Lanes will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. When bowling doubles, up to three bowlers per lane will be used.
6. Should a bowler be unable to complete their team event due to an emergency, a substitute will be allowed to complete their team event and the combined score will be counted for that team's total pins. Handicap will be adjusted accordingly.
7. Handicaps will use the team method to handicap 80% of 880 for team, 80% of 440 for doubles.
8. No practice bowling on any lanes assigned for tournament play. No pacers will be allowed.
9. Any bowler behaving in a derogatory or disorderly manner will be removed from the bowling area by tournament officials.
10. Any protest affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be submitted in writing to the tournament manager before prize payments are made. Errors in scoring must be reported to tournament officials within 24 hours.
11. **EARLY REGISTRATION & WALKUP ENTRIES:** As a courtesy to Westside Lanes, lane requirements for the tournament (based on early entries) will be turned in on Thursday, January 19 so other uses of their facility can be planned accordingly. The amount of walkup entries that can be handled on each shift will be at the sole discretion of Westside Lanes.
12. **All bowlers must be checked in 30 minutes prior to shift start time to allow for any last-minute changes.** Shifts will start as soon as all bowlers are checked in and tournament recaps are correct, or promptly at shift time. Late arriving bowlers will receive zeroes until they are ready to bowl.
13. The Missoula USBC Board of Directors shall decide on any question not covered by these tournament rules and shall have the power to hear and act on all protests arising from or under construction of the tournament rules. The decision of the Board of Directors is final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC rule 329.
14. The entrants whose names appear hereon or their replacements hereby agree that the Missoula USBC, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies or causes relating thereto or resulting therefore, fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of Missoula USBC.
